

Marlowe Manor Swimming Pool Rules

11:00 am – 8:00 pm Tuesday – Thursday

11:00 am- 9:00 pm Friday

1:00 pm – 8:00pm Sunday

Closed Monday

1. Only Marlowe Manor pool members and their paid visitors may use the pool.
2. Paid visitors of the pool must be accompanied by a member in good standing, at all times.
3. Any resident of the neighborhood may swim at the pool during the Neighborhood Pool Party days sponsored by the MMPOA so long as they have paid their annual POA dues.
4. A qualified lifeguard will supervise the swimming during pool hours and may clear the pool at any time.
5. All swimmers are strongly encouraged to shower in the pool dressing room before entering the pool to maintain water quality.
6. Misconduct, profanity and unruly behavior in the pools will not be tolerated.
7. Personal conduct in the pool and bathhouse must be such that the safety of self and others is not jeopardized.
8. The pool will close for 20 minutes in case of thunder or lightning.
9. Proper bathing suit attire is required. No cut-offs are allowed.
10. Children 12 years and over may swim unaccompanied by an adult after they have satisfied the lifeguard swim test. Children 9 years and under must be accompanied by an adult.
11. Items not allowed in the pool include glassware, pets, tire tubes, large rubber rafts, and stones. Large inflatables may be restricted at any time for safety reasons, including visibility and overcrowding concerns.
12. Only children 5 years old and younger are allowed in the baby pool at any time and must be accompanied by an adult at all times. Lifeguards are not responsible for guarding kids in the baby pool.
13. Children wearing diapers must wear swim diapers to prevent an accident from occurring in the pool.
14. Only children 12 years old and younger are allowed on the slide. Only feet first, sitting down slides are allowed. Only one child shall be on the slide at any one time. This includes the ladder of the slide.
15. Only jumping and diving straight off the end of the diving board is allowed.
16. Only one person on the diving board at any time. This includes the section of the diving board that is over the pool deck.
17. Double bouncing on the diving board is not allowed.
18. No diving anywhere within the shallow end of the pool.
19. No running within the pool area.
20. No one under 18 years old is allowed in the pool during Adult Swim.
21. Alcohol is allowed. Please drink responsibly. No glass containers of any type.
22. No photography or videoing allowed. (Parents may take pictures of their own children as long as there are no others in the background of the photograph.)

Any violation of these rules will result in appropriate disciplinary action.

Lifeguards reserve the right to refuse admission to anyone who violates any pool rule.

Lifeguards are the final authority and have a duty to uphold these rules. Please respect our lifeguards.
